

Brief Introduction

Want to copy and back up your recorded Blu-ray discs? Need a copy of your family party Blu-ray discs? Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy helps. Currently, there are quite a few options of Blu-ray copying software, but few of them works for recorded Blu-ray, not to mention those recorded Blu-ray discs with disc protection. Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy is specifically designed for homemade/recorded Blu-ray file backup. It helps you easily copy and back up BDAV disc, folder and even ISO file to blank disc or computer.



Main features of Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy:

- Decrypt, rip and copy any kind of recorded Blu-ray disc, folder and ISO file, regardless of disc protection and types.
- Copy BDAV to blank Blu-ray disc or computer hard drive in quality lossless backup.
- Copy BDAV content from BD50 to BD50 or BD25 to BD25 without quality loss.
- 1:1 copy BDAV files with all source elements retained like subtitles and audio tracks.
- Copied BDAV file is 100% compatible with any Blu-ray player.
- Copy BDAV content at 6X higher speed with GPU acceleration technologies.

How to Purchase and Activate Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy

Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy provides free trial version and registered version. Both versions have no differences in function. But there are indeed some differences between these 2 versions:


- Free trial version is valid for 30 days only. When the free trial version expires, encrypted BDAV files won't be loaded and read. Only non-encrypted BDAV files could be loaded and handled.
- Free trial version copies and backs up the first 5-minute content of source BDAV files only.

You could purchase license of Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy and activate it to break these limitations.

How to purchase license of Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy

The license of Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy is available in 1-year and lifetime. These 2 types of license differ from each other in the validity period only. Follow the below ways to purchase Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy license:

- Directly visit [Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy page](#) and click the "Buy Now" button. And then, on the purchase page, choose either 1-Year or Lifetime type of license before clicking the "Check Out Now" button. On the order page, input billing information and then payment information to complete the purchase. Once the purchase is complete, purchased license code will be sent to you via your registered email in no time.
- On Leawo Prof. Media program interface, click the "Activation center" icon  to call out the "Activation Center" interface, where you could see Blu-ray Recorder Copy module. Click the "Purchase" button to open the Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy purchase page and purchase license of Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy. If you have already activated any module of Leawo Prof. Media, you then click the "Renew" button next to Blu-ray Recorder Copy module to purchase license code.



How to activate Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy

With Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy license in hand, you could now activate the license code to enjoy its full features.

On Leawo Prof. Media program interface, click the “Activation center” icon  to call out the “Activation Center” interface. Then, copy and paste the license code into the blank bar on

“Activation Center” interface and then click the “Register” icon  to activate Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy module.

How to Copy BDAV File with Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy

Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy is a professional BDAV copy software tool that could help you decrypt and copy BDAV files to blank BD50/BD25 disc or computer hard drive without quality loss, regardless of disc protection and types. Check the below guide to learn how to copy homemade/recorded Blu-ray files with Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy.


Step 1: Enter Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy module

To copy BDAV files, you need to prepare the below things first:

- Readable Blu-ray drive connected to your computer for BDAV disc copy and backup.
- Source BDAV disc, folder or ISO image file for backup.
- Computer with Internet connection.
- Blank writable Blu-ray discs (BD50/BD25) for copying BDAV file to disc, or computer hard drive with enough space for copying BDAV file to computer.


Note: Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy supports BD50 to BD50 and BD25 to BD25 backup only. So, prepare a blank Blu-ray disc according to the source Blu-ray disc type for BDAV disc backup.

Download and install Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy on your computer. Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy is a module built in [Leawo Prof. Media](#).




After installing Leawo Prof. Media on your computer, kick it off. Click the “Copy” tab on the top or “Blu-ray Recorder Copy” option in the middle to enter the Blu-ray Recorder Copy module.

Step 2: Add source BDAV files




On the “Copy” tab, click the “Add UHD/Blu-ray/DVD” drop-down button and then click “Add from

CD-ROM”, “Add from folder” or “Add iso file” option according to your needs.



After loading source BDAV file, you need to choose the output disc type from the bottom left corner. Choose the disc type (BD-50 or BD-25) according to the source Blu-ray type. You could also play back loaded BDAV titles, view all loaded titles, subtitles and audio tracks for backup. The output will retain all elements in source BDAV file in Full Movie mode.

Step 3: Specify copy settings




With source BDAV files loaded, click the green “Copy” button to call out the copy setting panel. On the popup sidebar, you need to specify some copy settings, including “Copy to”, “Disc Label” and “Save to” options. Choose to copy BDAV file to folder, ISO file or blank disc under the “Copy to” option according to your needs, name the “Disc Label” and set the “Save to” directory. It will show you how much space the backup requires and how much free space the target drive has.

The clickable drop-down button right next to the folder icon  refers to how many copies you want to get for output, which could only be clickable for copying BDAV file to Blu-ray disc.

Note: If you haven’t activated Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy module, there will be a “Notice” showing you the limitation of free trial version of Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy module. You could purchase and activate it, or take a try of the free trial version by clicking “Agree” option.


Step 4: Start copying BDAV file



Finally, click the “Copy” button at the bottom of the sidebar to start copying BDAV to blank disc or computer hard drive. Then you will see the “Copying” panel, which showcases you the detailed copying progress. You could cancel/stop copying BDAV files anytime you like, and set after-done operation at the bottom right corner.

How to Set Leawo Blu-ray Recorder Copy




On the top-right corner of Leawo Prof. Media, you could see a few icons, which are described in detail below:

- **Feedback:** Click the “feedback” icon  to send feedback of using Leawo Prof. Media, like advice, review, function need, etc.
- **Activation center:** Click the “Activation center” icon  to enter the Activation Center interface for registering and activating Leawo Prof. Media modules.
- **Settings:** Click the “Settings” icon  to set Leawo Prof. Media, which will be described below in detail.
- **Help center:** Click the “Help center” icon  to get more help from Leawo, like visiting Home page and Tutorial page, sending Bug Report, checking for update, purchasing, registering, rating, etc.


Leawo Prof. Media provides multiple program settings for you to better use this program. You could click the “Settings” icon  to set Leawo Prof. Media, including:

General settings




On the “General” tab, you could set program UI language and other settings.

Conversion settings




On the “Conversion” tab, choose to enable Priority native codec, streaming MP4 video, DVD navigator, max run, etc.

Copy & Burn settings




On “Copy & Burn” tab, set Burning Engine, default video mode for DVD, source Blu-ray region code, etc.

Performance settings



On “Performance” tab, set CPU core, choose to enable hardware decode, and choose GPU acceleration.

Others settings



On “Others” tab, set external subtitle position, default encoding, screenshot saving directory and format, automatic update, etc.
