

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Introduction – What is Leawo iOSFix?

Leawo iOSFix is a powerful all-in-one iOS system repair tool that can easily, quickly and safely fix more than 50 types of iOS system errors such as white Apple logo, black screen, stuck in DFU mode, boot loop, no service, etc. It can detect nearly all iOS devices (iPhone, iPad and iPod) and Apple TV sets, and helps you restore the iOS system to the best state before problem occurred, getting your iDevices back to normal.



As the most powerful iOS system repair program, what can Leawo iOSFix do for you:

1. Fix 50+ iOS/tvOS issues on iPhone, iPad, iPod or Apple TV;
2. 2 repair modes for data lossless fixing;
3. Fix all iOS and tvOS versions in clicks;
4. Multiple iOS/tvOS system fixing paths;
5. One-click to upgrade to the latest iOS/tvOS version;
6. One-click to enter/exit Recovery Mode;
7. Troubleshoot iOS/tvOS not recognized issues in detail.

How to Register Leawo iOSFix

Leawo iOSFix provides free trial versions and registration versions, both of which are available to download, install and experience for free, without malware and spyware. However, there are some differences between free trial version, registered version and expired version.

1. Differences Between Free Trial and Registration Versions

Check the table below to understand the differences between free trial version, registered version and expired version:

Note: Expired version provides all functions available in registered version, but without free updates and technical support from Leawo Software. Expired version will become free trial version if you hard-upgrade the program.

2. Differences Between 1-Year License and Lifetime License

Check the table below to understand the differences between 1-year license and lifetime license:

	1-Year License	Lifetime License
Price	\$39.95	\$49.95
Supported iDevices	1-5 iDevices	1-3 PCs
Supported PCs	1-10 iDevices	1-3 PCs

Note: One registration code can only be registered on 3 PCs, and fix 5 iDevices (1-year license) / 10 iDevices (lifetime license) of all registered PCs. To expand more available devices, just purchase corresponding license according to your demands.

3. How To Purchase Registration License of Leawo iOSFix

There are 2 paths for you to purchase registration license/activation code of Leawo iOSFix for registering, through official website and program interface respectively.

Purchase license from website

1. Go to the official website of Leawo iOSFix at <https://www.leawo.org/iosfix/>
2. Click the “Buy Now” button.
3. Choose the license between “1 Year License” and “Lifetime License”, then proceed to complete the payment.
4. License will be automatically sent to your email.

Purchase license from program interface


1. Fire up Leawo iOSFix on your computer.
2. Click “Buy” button on the top right corner.
3. On the “Get Pro” panel, you will see the differences between Trial version and Pro version.
4. Click “Buy Pro” button to head to the official purchase page on Leawo.org.
5. Choose a license between “1 Year License” and “Lifetime License”, then proceed to complete the payment.
6. License will be automatically sent to your email.

4. How to Register Leawo iOSFix

With the registration license, you can now register Leawo iOSFix to get your iDevices back to normal with ease. Follow the guide below to register Leawo iOSFix:

Step 1: Launch Leawo iOSFix


Kick off Leawo iOSFix on your computer after installation completes.




Step 2: Enter Register interface

Leawo iOSFix offers 2 entries for you to enter the Register interface:

1. Click the “Buy” button on the top-right corner. On the “Get Pro” panel, click “Register” button to enter “Register” interface.




2. Click “Settings” button in the three-bar icon on the top-right corner, then click “Register” option on drop-and-down panel to enter “Register” interface.



Step 3: Register Leawo iOSFix with license

On the “Register” interface, simply copy and paste the license received via email into the “Registration Code” box. Then click the right arrow icon to successfully activate Leawo iOSFix.




5. How to Check Leawo iOSFix Availability

After registration, you can now make full use of Leawo iOSFix to fix your iDevices. Follow the guide below to check the registration information of Leawo iOSFix:


Step 1: Enter Reg Info interface

Leawo iOSFix offers 2 paths for you to enter the Reg Info interface:

1. After registration, the “Buy” button on the top-right corner will become to “Pro” button. Click it to enter the “Get Pro” panel, in which the grey “Trial” button will turn to yellow and show license duration and repaired iDevices. Click it to enter Reg Info interface.




2. Click “Settings” button in the three-bar icon on the top-right corner, and then click “Register” option on drop-and-down panel to enter “Register” interface. A yellow “Reg Info” button will appear next to “Renew” button. Click to enter Reg Info interface.



Step 2: Check license duration and devices


On the License Duration and Devices interface, you can view a full list of your repaired devices, including device name, device ID and repair date. In the upper right corner of the interface, you can see the remaining days of your license.



How to Set Leawo iOSFix


Setting up Leawo iOSFix is an effortless job for even novices. You can determine the program UI language and set saving directory for downloaded firmware in simple clicks.

Set program UI language



Once you have launched Leawo iOSFix on your computer, click “Settings” button in the three-dot icon on the top-right corner, and then navigate to “Language” option. The multiple UI language panel will pop up with several options: Simplified Chinese, English, French, Japanese and German. Choose preferred language to set program UI language for this iOS repair tool.

Set saving directory for downloaded firmware




Click “Settings” button in the three-dot icon on the top-right corner, and then navigate to “Setting” option. Click on the “Setting” option, and there will pop up a “Setting” panel where you can set directory for downloaded firmware. Click the three-point icon or “Open” button to browse and choose a directory for saving downloaded firmware in the “Repair file download” box. You can also tick on “Automatically delete the file after completion” to let this iOS repair tool automatically delete the downloaded firmware after repairing your iDevices to keep your computer tidy.

How to Use Leawo iOSFix

Leawo iOSFix works as a professional but easy-to-use iOS repair tool that allows you to set up the program and repair your iDevices in just a few clicks. Everything will be done quickly and safely. The below guide will show you detailed steps on how to use Leawo iOSFix in both “Standard Mode” and “Advanced Mode”.


Step 1: Connect your iOS device to computer

Connect your iOS device to computer with USB cable, and then launch Leawo iOSFix. Your device will be automatically detected and be shown on the main interface. You can browse devices and models supported by iOSFix in “Works on” drop-and-down menu.



Step 2: Choose a repair mode


Click to choose one of two modes to continue.




Note: “Standard Mode” can fix most iOS system issues by retaining all data. “Advanced Mode” offers more thorough solution to fix iOS system issues by erasing all data. Try “Advanced Mode” only if the “Standard Mode” fails. Make sure you have backed up your device before adopting “Advanced Mode”.

Step 3: Download firmware

Your device model and system version will be detected intelligently. Confirm your device model and system version, and then click “Download Now” button to download the proper firmware for your device.




You can also download the firmware from website by clicking “Download” button if it is unable to download by default. Or if you have had a downloaded firmware on your computer, click “Select” to browse and choose the firmware for the next step.




Note: Make sure your network is stable during download process.

With a complete and strong database, iOSFix will verify the firmware after downloading, to ensure that the downloaded firmware best matches your device.



Step 4: Start fixing

Click on "Fix Now" to get your device back to normal.



How to Enter/Exit Recovery Mode in One-click? (Completely Free)

Leawo iOSFix offers completely free service for one-click to enter or exit Recovery Mode without any data loss, no extra operation is required. If you want to enter Recovery Mode for flashing or upgrade/downgrade, or exit when your device unknowingly stuck in Recovery Mode, try this simple method.

Step 1: Connect your iDevice to computer

Connect your iOS device to computer with USB cable, and then launch Leawo iOSFix. Your device status will be automatically detected.

If it shows “Enter Recovery Mode”, that means your device has not yet entered Recovery Mode.

Enter Recovery Mode


If it shows “Exit Recovery Mode”, that means your device is already in Recovery Mode.

Quit Recovery Mode

Step 2: One-click to enter/exit Recovery Mode for free

Click the button under the device model option to enter/exit Recovery Mode for free.

If your device cannot quit Recovery Mode in this way, you have to click on “Start” for further repair.



Note: This function is applicable to Recovery Mode only, but not to DFU Mode

What If Your iDevices Cannot be Recognized?

If your iOS device is not working properly and cannot be recognized by the software, Leawo iOSFix will display “Device is not connected” on its interface. Follow the steps below to boot your iOS device into Recovery Mode or DFU Mode for further repair.

How to Boot Your iOS Device into Recovery Mode?

Boot iPhone 7/7 Plus into Recovery Mode

Step 1: Turn off your device and connect it to your computer.

Step 2: Press and hold the Power button and the Volume Down button at the same time.

Step 3: Keep holding them until you see the recovery-mode screen.

Boot iPhone 8 or later iPhones into Recovery Mode

Step 1: Turn off your device and connect it to your computer.

Step 2: Press and quickly release the Volume Up button. Press and quickly release the Volume Down button. Then press and hold the Power button.

Step 3: Keep holding Power button until you see the recovery-mode screen.

Boot Apple TV into Recovery Mode

Step 1: Connect your Apple TV to the computer with a Micro-USB cable. Plug in the power cord for 3rd generation and leave 2nd generation unplugged.

Step 2: Press and hold Menu and Down buttons on the Remote. Release them until you see the indicator light on the box start flashing rapidly.

Step 3: Keep holding Menu and Play/Pause button for 6s and then release them.

Boot Apple TV HD into Recovery Mode

Step 1: Connect your Apple TV HD to the computer with a USD-C cable. Plug in the power cord.

Step 1: Turn off your device and connect it to your computer.

Step 2: Press and hold the Home button and the Power button at the same time,

How to Boot Your iOS Device into DFU Mode?

Boot iPhone 7/7 Plus into DFU Mode

Step 1: Turn off your device and connect it to your computer.

Step 2: Press and hold the Power button and the Volume Down button for 8 seconds.

Step 3: Release the Power button, but still keep holding the Volume Down button for about 5 seconds.

Boot iPhone 8 or later iPhones into DFU Mode

Step 1: Connect device to computer and trust. Quick press Volume Up button and release. Quick press Volume Down button and release. Press and hold Power button for 10s.

Step 2: While holding Power button, press and hold Volume Down button for 5s.

Step 3: Release Power button but keep holding Volume Down button for another 10s.
